When will e-learning begin?

E-learning/distance learning will begin Monday, March 30th if necessary.

What grade levels will participate in e-learning?

Students in grades kindergarten through eighth grade will participate. Preschool students' families will receive communication from Mrs. Carroll, preschool director.

How will my child know what to do each day?

Each grade level homeroom teacher will reach out to you via email by Friday, March 27th to communicate the e-learning framework for your child. Then, going forward, teachers will share assignments, videos, and learning activities for your child to complete at home. Grades K-3 will also utilize Seesaw to communicate with families, and grades 4-8 will use Google Classroom.

What if my child participates in band, special education classes, or English language classes at Rosemount Elementary or Rosemount Middle School?

Your child's teacher at Rosemount Elementary or Rosemount Middle School will reach out to you directly with information and instructions.
